Suicide is the third leading cause of death for youth 16-25 in Santa Barbara County. (Santa Barbara County Dept. of Behavioral Wellness, 2018)

22% of students in grade 7, 28% in grade 9, and 33% in grade 11 have experienced chronic and debilitating feelings of sadness and hopelessness in the past year. (California Healthy Kids Survey, 2017)

Students have a greater awareness of gun violence and rising fear for their safety. (Bubash, K., Santa Maria Sun, 2018.)

Half of all chronic mental illness begins by age 14. It is critical that parents, educators, and others working with youth receive training to recognize and safely respond to the signs and symptoms of mental illness.
